Gary Salmans, Young At Heart Chaplain, is our guest speaker today.

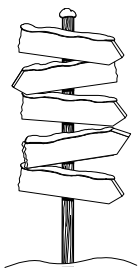
Food For Thought

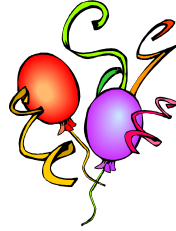
