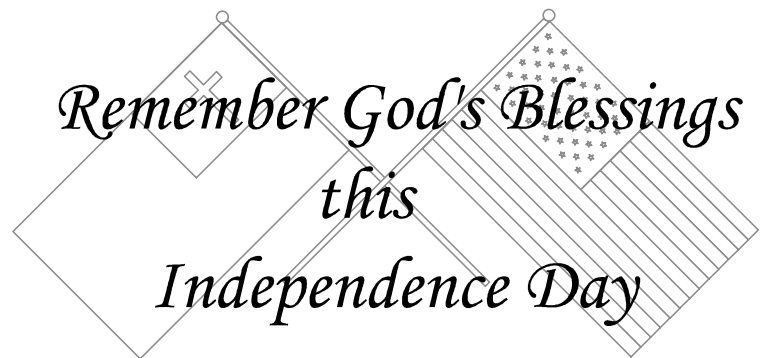

America is great because she is good, and if America ever ceases to be good, America will cease to be great. - Alexis Charles Henri Clérel de Tocqueville



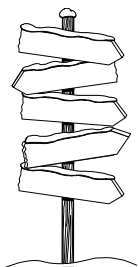
Mission Statement

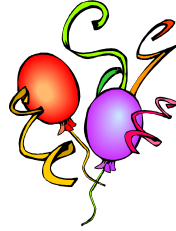
